**ROLLED BANDAGES, MEDICAL SUPPLIES, AND OPERATION WARM BABY**

**ALWAYS BEFORE MAILING A PACKAGE DO THE FOLLOWING**

1. **SIZE/WEIGHT/COSTS:** Check with your local post office for updated instructions or go to [www.USPS.com/business/international](http://www.USPS.com/business/international)
  2. **MARK PACKAGE:** “Not for Resale” unless otherwise noted.
  3. **VALUE:** None (If post office insists on a value, put “50” cents.)
  4. **DUTY:** Send \$2.00 per package to Global Treasury Services for all countries.
  5. **FORMS:** Place a Parcel Form (X-13) in each package mailed. This form is included in the annual NMI convention packet and may be copied. It may be ordered from NPH for *postage only*, or downloaded from [www.nazarenemissionsinternational.org/10117/story.aspx](http://www.nazarenemissionsinternational.org/10117/story.aspx)
  6. **INFORM:** Write the missionary or contact person (e-mail address is available from your district LINKS coordinator.) whenever a box is mailed, stating when the box was sent and what was sent.
  7. **E-MAIL:** **Provide an e-mail address for acknowledgment of package.**
